

EPISCOPAL CHURCH HOME

The Board of Directors for the Episcopal Church Home and the Rt. Rev. Don E. Johnson approved \$335,114 in 2009 grants to diocesan churches and institutions for programs serving youth in West Tennessee. Recipients were:

- Church of the Annunciation, \$40,000, for Director of Children's and Youth Ministry and partnership with Emmanuel Episcopal Church
- Church of the Holy Apostles, \$37,707, for Director of Youth Ministries
- Church of the Redeemer, \$7,300, for staff coordinator for Junior High Ministry and for Vacation Bible School
- Emmanuel Episcopal Center, \$60,000, for After School and Camp Hope programs
- Emmanuel Episcopal Church, \$14,000, for Pathfinders Program
- Happening Steering Committee, \$3,000, for program expenses
- Holy Trinity Episcopal Church, \$1,500, for child care and Ice Cream Ministry
- Memphis Boychoir, \$4,000, for purchase of music and choir robes
- St. Columba Conference Center, \$16,500, for at-risk children to attend summer camp
- St. Elisabeth's Episcopal Church, \$59,607, for Director of Children and Family Ministries
- St. Mary's Episcopal Cathedral, \$4,500, for start-up monies for summer arts camp
- St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Mason, \$30,750, for program for grade-appropriate reading and writing instruction
- St. Philip Episcopal Church, \$40,000, for Director of Youth and Family Ministry
- The Diocese of West Tennessee, \$16,250, to support Diocesan Youth Council events

The Episcopal Church Home awards grants to diocesan organizations for ministries designed to enrich the physical, spiritual or emotional development of youth located within The Diocese of West Tennessee.
