Biographical information (no more than 150 words)

All nominations shall include the nominator's name, parish or mission, and city. The nominator shall obtain the nominee's consent and willingness to serve prior to submitting a nomination. Nominations shall be in writing and include the nominee's name, parish or mission, city, **email address, cell phone number**, a recent photo, and biographical information (no more than 150 words) giving past and present service of the nominee to the Church at all levels. **Nominations should be submitted by e-mail, typed and saved in Microsoft Word format, to diocese@episwtn.org. Please submit photo by e-mail in jpeg format.** Nominations received by October 1, 2018 will be included in the Convention White Book. Additional written nominations for this office may be made by filing with the Secretary of the Convention by 12 noon, November 16, 2018. **Nominees submitting information after October 1, 2018 are responsible for bringing 150 copies of their nomination form to distribute at Convention.** All written nominations shall be posted at the Convention. Nominations may be made only by the Bishop of this Diocese, the Clerical and Lay Delegates, and any other person(s) authorized by Canon. Nominees must be confirmed adult members (18 years of age or older) of their parish or mission.
