

NOMINATION FORM FOR STANDING COMMITTEE:

TWO LAY MEMBERS

The Thirty-ninth Convention will elect one Lay member of the Standing Committee for an unexpired term ending at Convention in 2023, and one Lay Member for a term ending at Convention in 2024. Requirements for nomination: (1) The nominee must be at least 18 years old. (2) The nominee must be a Confirmed Adult Lay Communicant in Good Standing in this Diocese. (3) The nominee must be resident in this Diocese for at least 1 year. (4) Since lay members from Emmanuel Memphis, St. Luke's Jackson and Immanuel Ripley are currently elected members of the Standing Committee, nominees may not be from any of these Faith Communities. *Article IX of the Constitution*

Dates for Standing Committee Meetings:

The SC will meet at 4 pm on the following dates in 2021: January 28, March 25, June 24, August 26 and October 28.

Description of Standing Committee Duties

- (1) The SC oversees the administrative and executive functions of this Diocese if there is no Bishop (Ecclesiastical Authority).
- (2) The SC serves as a Council of Advice to the Bishop.
- (3) The SC plays an integral role in determining the suitability of persons for ordination and other matters pertaining to clergy in this Diocese.
- (4) The SC must advise the Bishop and consent to the sale, lease or other encumbrance or alienation of property used solely for Divine Worship in this Diocese.
